An Infrastructure Renewal Committee is being commissioned at OLPH with the mandate to prepare a comprehensive plan for dealing with OLPH parish's infrastructure renewal and looking into the future site planning in order to best deal with growth and development.

The mandate of the Infrastructure Renewal Committee is:

- to promote and develop the Archdiocese 's strategic direction in infrastructure renewal
- to provide leadership to the parish through project activities in infrastructure renewal
- to represent the parish with respect to infrastructure renewal, in its interactions with the Archdiocese, and with the city of Vancouver and experts in the field to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements
- to make strategic infrastructure decisions that will have positive impact for the parish, now and for the future
- to develop a master site plan to prepare the parish for growth in the coming years
- to develop a concept plan for the re-purposing of the existing rectory
- to develop a strategic plan to guide its decision making
- and to deliver a budget that makes smart investments in infrastructure and to communicate the funding required.

Our aim is that this would be comprehensive, mission/vision-focused and long-term, preparing the parish for future growth and development.

Apart from having a good team in place to move forward with this planning, your financial support is critical. This year's Project Advance funds will be directed toward the preliminary work involved. Your generous and prayerful support would be very much appreciated.
