# Venerable Carlo: Boy Who Loved the Eucharist

Carlo Acutis who died of leukemia at the age of 15, offering his suffering for the pope and for the Church, was among four laypeople whose heroic virtues were recognized by the Congregation for the Causes of Saints last Thursday. Pope Francis authorized the congregation to promulgate the decree July 5, which advances Acutis' cause and names him Venerable. Acutis was born in London May 3, 1991, to Italian parents who returned to Milan. He was a pious child, attending daily Mass, frequently praying the rosary and making weekly confessions.

Exceptionally gifted in working with computers, Acutis developed a website

which catalogued Eucharistic miracles. This website was the genesis of The Eucharistic Miracles of the World, an international exhibition which highlights such occurrences. Acutis died of leukemia in Monza on Oct. 12, 2006.

A quote by him: "Our aim has to be the infinite and not the finite. The Infinite is our homeland. We have always been expected in Heaven." He also called the Eucharist "my highway to heaven." www.cna.or
