Welcome the New Members of the Elect in Our Midst

Dear Parishioners.

This past Sunday, members of the RCIA group took a big step forward in their journey of discovery of the love of God. They solemnly declared in the Rite of Election that they are ready to be initiated into the faith of the Church. They are no longer catechumens, rather they are members of the Elect, so called because they have responded to God's invitation to enter fully into the life of the Church through Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist. Congratulations to all them! As well as thanks to our dedicated RCIA team and sponsors who are accompanying them in their discovery.

Because of the pandemic, the Rite of Election which is normally celebrated at Holy Rosary Cathedral with Archbishop Miller, was hosted individually by parishes. A highlight of the Cathedral ceremony has always been the signing of the Book of the Elect which each catechumen does as part of the ceremony. Not to worry, the names of the Elect will be sent to the Archdiocese of Vancouver to be officially entered into the Book of the Elect.

Saturday: 6pm - 6:30pm Sunday: 10am - 10:30am / 12pm -12:30pm

Drive up or walk to the Communion station on Crown Street at the front of the Church to receive the Eucharist after attending a live-streamed Mass at home. Stay in your car, roll down your window and extend your arm to receive Communion then move on. To keep traffic moving, please avoid making a left turn onto West 10th Ave.
