

Honouring the 'Lily of the Mohawks'

Dear Parishioners,



If you visited the church in the last couple of weeks you would have noticed our newest window on the southside of the church interior. It is dedicated to St Kateri Tekakwitha, the first North American Indigenous woman to be canonized by the Church. I feel a personal connection with this saint because of the work of the Redemptorists with indigenous communities in Saskatoon.

St Mary's Parish, where I was stationed before coming here, ministered to a large indigenous congregation. There was a respectful exchange of ideas on faith and spirituality, creative expression of First Nations culture in liturgy and ample blessings and bannock for all. I encourage parents with children at home for Spring break to read about or watch a video on the 'Lily of the Mohawks,' as St Kateri is known. Her feast day is celebrated on April 17 in Canada.

Looking ahead to Holy Week, we still don't have definitive news about how the Triduum will be celebrated but we are working on a couple of possible scenarios. More information will be made available to you as soon as I have it. A reminder -Part 2 of our Lent Retreat with Brother John Gale is ongoing. Please tune in using the Zoom link below.

I am glad people have also been tuning in to our Friday Stations of the Cross and visiting the Outdoor Stations of the Cross. On Good Friday, there will be sign-ups for Stations of the Cross every hour for 12 hours starting at 8am and finishing at 8pm with prayer leaders to help you along. There will be no 3pm signup because that is the time of the Good Friday liturgy. Signups will be set up next week.

Saturday: 6pm - 6:30pm Sunday: 10am - 10:30am / 12pm -12:30pm Drive up or walk to the Communion station on Crown Street at the front of the Church to receive the Eucharist after attending a live-streamed Mass at home. Stay in your car, roll down your window and extend your arm to receive Communion then move on. To keep traffic moving, please avoid making a left turn onto West 10th Ave.
