

August 29, 2021 Hearts With A Desire To Draw Close To God Dear Parishioners,

This Friday we celebrate the Feast of St Monica and following that we celebrate the feast of her son, the great St. Augustine. Those who attend daily Mass generally develop a familiarity with the lives of the saints as their feast days come up on the liturgical calendar. For others, I mention the saints' feasts here in the hope that you may be inspired by their lives of virtue and prayer usually following tremendous struggles.

As a priest and pastor, I am constantly approached by parents worried about their children not following in their footsteps of the Faith especially in matters such as baptizing the grandchildren, attending Sunday Mass or praying as a family. These experiences may bring some sadness to family life. Just remember, we should never give up hope. The life of St Monica is a prime example and witness of persistence in prayer. The bio of her life says she prayed 17 years for her son to turn away from a sinful life. Not only did he convert, both he and she became well-known and wellloved saints. It is for these reasons that St Monica is the patron saint of conversions, wives, mothers, alcoholics and abuse victims. St Augustine is the patron saint of theologians, printers and brewers...the last being a testament to his hedonistic lifestyle before his conversion.

In this week's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that we are to honour Him with our hearts and not just our lips. If we fill our hearts with a true desire to grow closer to him, like St Monica and later St Augustine, we will most certainly create the right conditions for this to happen. Let us ask for the assistance of our Mother of Perpetual Help for her help in our prayers to accomplish this.
