First Sunday of Advent

Reaching Out To Those Who Do Not Know Jesus

Dear Parishioners,

There is always an air of eager anticipation when the season of Advent begins. Putting up lights, baking treats and planning family gatherings are great ways to prepare for the season. However, the preparation that brings the deepest joy to the heart is remembering the One whose coming we will celebrate.

There are many ways to engage our hearts for this. Making sure you have quiet time for prayer is the most of these. We have an Advent prayer service next Saturday Dec 4 at 7pm organized by the Music Ministry. The readings are inspirations from Fulton Sheen and Henri Nouwen. The Redemptorist Associates are also putting on a retreat with readings from the works of St Alphonsus. The focus is on Jesus in the crib, a tender contemplation of what it means to experience the presence of God as man.

MISSIONARY OUTREACH

The inspiration for our congregation came to St Alphonsus as he found himself in the hill country of Scala away from the churches and busy pulse of Naples. There he lived among the poor, simple folks who had no exposure to the Gospel and limited means to receive the sacraments. St Alphonsus felt a strong urge to reach out to these communities. Missionary outreach continues to be a priority for the Redemptorists to this day even though it may look a little different from the days of St Alphonsus.

The final instalment of the Redemptorist document we've been talking about over the last few weeks, talks about this. It proposes a few unique ways we can reach out to those who do not know Jesus even as we work out of parish settings. Some suggestions are:

- Opening our premises to those in our neighbourhood so that they may know who we are and what we are about

- Reaching out to others in programs such as soup kitchens, offering legal counsel to refugees and immigrants, homeless shelters etc. including people of all faiths or those of no faith at all

- Using technology to create more virtual communities offering novenas, podcasts and studies

- Collaborating with parishioners on ecological goals that recognize that the cry of the earth and the cry of the poor are closely connected
