



The Ascension of Our Lord reminds us that our lives are brimming with promise and expectation. It is a reminder desperately needed when our spirits are troubled by news of war and the loss of innocent lives. In the days leading up to his departure, Jesus was keenly aware of the anxiety of his disciples. But he reassures them, "you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you and you will be my witnesses...to the ends of the earth."


This expectation is echoed in St Paul's letter to the Ephesians. He prays that we may all receive the spirit of wisdom and revelation so that "with your eyes enlightened, you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance among the saints; and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power for us who believe." It is this gift of the Holy Spirit that gives us hope, courage and strength.
