The Elderly Can Be Poets of Prayer

Dear Parishioners,

For this Sunday's 2nd World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, Pope Francis speaks about prayer, understanding, and a spirit of tender revolution which seniors can lovingly use to bring about peace and conversion.

"Our world is passing through a time of trial and testing, beginning with the sudden, violent outbreak of the pandemic, and then a war which is harming peace and development on a global scale. It is also no coincidence that war is returning to Europe at a time when the last generation to experience it is dying out."

He said, "All this points to the need for a profound change, a conversion that disarms hearts and leads us to see others as our brothers or sisters. We, grandparents and elderly people, have a great responsibility: to teach the women and men of our time to regard others with the same understanding and loving gaze with which we regard our own grandchildren."

He said, "We ourselves have grown in humanity by caring for others, and now we can be teachers of a way of life that is peaceful and attentive to those in greatest need. This attitude may be mistaken for weakness or resignation, yet it will be the meek, not the aggressive and the abusive, who will inherit the earth (cf. Mt 5:5)."

On prayer, the pope said seniors are called to bear a spirit of tender revolution by wielding the most valuable instrument at our disposal, prayer. He said the elderly could be "poets of prayer" joining their own words with the Word of God. This trusting prayer is a companion to the cry of pain of those who suffer and can help heal troubled hearts.

I would like to thank families who made a special effort to bring grandparent(s) and the elderly to Mass this weekend. A special blessing is being given at all Masses, as well as a gift bag for those over 65.

Let us ask Saints Anne and Joachim, grandparents of Jesus, whose feast we celebrate this Tuesday, to pray for us.
