

A watering can, to illustrate the care that must be given to seedlings to ensure their growth, which is like the care that Development and Peace — Caritas Canada's partners give to the communities they accompany so that they can reap their rights.



A transparent glass, Mason jar or beaker containing soil, water and oil allowed to naturally settle into three layers, to represent the contamination of land by decades of socially irresponsible oil extraction in Nigeria.

He is the Director of Paya Payo which organizes women to do sustainable farming in Indonesia. Karno is giving talks all over the lower mainland and Vancouver Island thanking parishioners for their support.
