THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

On August 15, we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Heaven. This is a dogma of the Church, declared on November 1, 1950 by Pope Pius XII, though it had been believed and celebrated in the Church throughout history that Mary was taken directly to heaven after her time on earth had ended.

Meaning of the Assumption: The Assumption of Mary to Heaven is the sign of all that has been accomplished through the work of Christ. In her we witness the resurrection of the body and the new creation which has been promised. Mary's Assumption is the guarantee of the final resurrection of all the faithful.

The Church is the community of the "now" and the "not yet." Mary makes visible the "now." In Mary, we see that the final triumph of God over evil is already accomplished, even though time has not run its full course.

In her Assumption, Mary is oriented to the fullness of the kingdom and every part of her has been united with God in Three Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Church, too, will one day be oriented to the fullness of the kingdom and every part of the Church will be united with God. Any who look on Mary cannot help but see the glory of God which she reflects so perfectly. So too, at the end of time, every aspect of the Church will be united with God so that all who look on the Church will see the kingdom of God in its fullness. ~ Ave Maria Press

ARE YOU THINKING OF BECOMING CATHOLIC?




