



In this week's Sunday Gospel, Jesus told the people the plain truth about the Holy Eucharist - "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you." Many disciples turned and walked away from Jesus. Jesus then turned towards His twelve and asked if they would like to go away as well. Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go?"

Let us ponder on Peter's answer to Jesus. Come think of it .. Is there an alternative to God? If we cannot find joy and peace following the footsteps of God, where else can we turn? Like those who walked away from Jesus, there are many times we walk away from God when our desires are not met. We begin to question the existence of God. It is precisely at such moments that we should say with Peter, "Lord, to whom shall we go?" Peter chose to put his trust in God although he himself did not understand fully what Jesus meant by "eat His flesh and drink His blood." It is impossible that we trust God because we know everything about God. We trust because we believe He is all we have. Like the Holy Eucharist, there are still many things about God that remain mysterious to us. Let us remember that God has not changed and will never change. Just hold on. Do not quit on God.

Let us pray .. Heavenly Father, when I feel like giving up, speak Your word to the depths of my heart. Deepen my love for You and work through me always. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

#### CATHOLIC FAITH FORMATION FOR CHILDREN NOT IN CATHOLIC SCHOOL




