CONGRATULATIONS to Reverend Father Charles Duval, CSsR, on being elected as the Coadjutor Archbishop of the Metropolitan Archdiocese of Grouard-McLennan in Canada

Redemptorist Father Charles Duval, who is currently pastor of St. Joseph Parish in Grande Prairie, Alberta, has been appointed by the Holy Father as the Coadjutor Archbishop for the Grouard-McLennan Archdiocese. Fr. Charles entered the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer on August 18, 1985, and professed solemn vows on July 29, 1989. He obtained a

Bachelor's degree and a Master's degree in Theology from the Université Laval in Quebec. His priestly ordination took place on June 12, 1993, in the church of Notre-Dame-du-Perpétuel-Secours in Sherbrooke.

Jubilee 2025 HOLY DOOR

The Holy Door is the most powerful sign of the Jubilee since the ultimate aim of the pilgrim is to pass through it. The opening of the door by the Pope constitutes the official beginning of the Holy Year. Originally, there was only one door, at the Basilica of St. John Lateran, which is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome. Later, to allow as many pilgrims as possible to participate in the Jubilee experience, the six other Roman Basilicas also opened their own holy doors.

In crossing the threshold of the Holy Door, the pilgrim is reminded of the passage from chapter 10 of St John's gospel: "I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture." Passing through the Holy Door expresses the decision to follow and be guided by Jesus, who is the Good Shepherd. The door is a passageway that ushers the pilgrim into the interior of a church. For the Christian community, a church is not only a sacred space to be approached with respect, with appropriate behaviour and dress code, but it is a symbol of the communion that binds every believer to Christ: it is a place of encounter and dialogue, reconciliation and peace which awaits every pilgrim, the Church is essentially the place of the community of the faithful. In the Archdiocese of Vancouver, the Open Holy Door in Rome will be symbolized by a special cross at Holy Rosary Cathedral, which local pilgrims visit as a point of destination for their journey.
