QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY




"Since the great Virgin Mary was raised to the dignity of Mother of the King of Kings, the Church justly honors her, and wishes that she be honored with the glorious title of Queen," - St. Alphonsus de Liguori.

Catholics celebrate the Queenship of Mary because her Divine Son is King. Pope Pius XII, having declared the dogma of the Assumption, that "the Immaculate Mother of God ... was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory," then established the feast of her Queenship. He set the date for the octave after the Solemnity of the Assumption, that is, <u>AUGUST 22</u> each year.
