This year, the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica falls on a Sunday. The feast does not commemorate a saint, or a biblical event. It celebrates the official “Home” of the Pope. The Lateran symbolically proclaims the Church coming out from the shadows, proclaiming the Kingdom of God. So the feast is not so much about a church in Rome, but about the Church, our Church, your Church, and the proclamation and witness to the Kingdom of God that continues to this very day. The Lateran is significant because of what flows from it, the Body of Christ, missionary disciples, sent into the world, into our communities, to be Christ’s living presence in the world.
