



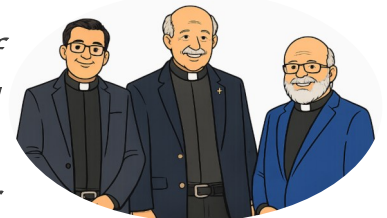
June 21, 2026 ❖ 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

EASTER REFUGEE PROJECT



A Thank You Note From Fr. Mark Miller



My Dear Parishioners of OLPH,

The donations for the Refugee project to sponsor the nine-member family to come to Canada as refugees has reached the required goal. Indeed, there has been such a flurry of donations as we approached the goal that the Fund may well have a small surplus, for which I ask your indulgence to retain as 'refugee support' by Our Lady of Perpetual Help Parish. The \$122,119.99 is the sponsorship money that Immigration Canada requires to cover accommodations and groceries during their first year in Canada. During that year, the adults will be expected to find work or get the training necessary for particular careers, all to establish their financial independence in Canada. (I would point out that the extra refugee funds held at OLPH could be a great resource, if needed, for training or credentialing courses.)

The next step involves an interview of the family, by Immigration Canada and according to their timeline, to determine the legitimacy of their refugee claim. Once acceptance is granted, there are medical exams to undergo. Then a travel date and flight arrangements are established. And at this point our local Support Group prepares to help the family find accommodation, get proper documentation, explore possibilities for work or training, and deal with the hundreds of little things needed to understand and adjust to life in Canada (like cheering for the Oilers...oops, I mean the Canucks).

I cannot adequately express my deepest gratitude to this community for your generosity and support as well as for your encouragement. This is a work of God and it is a privilege for us to participate in it and to entrust it to God, especially through continued prayer. May God bless you all !
